inspires millions to embark on their own journey of self-discovery.



KNOW THE KUMBH BATHING RITUALS

The Maha Kumbh is a celebration of rituals including pujas (worship), discourses and magnificent processions. However, the bathing ritual is the most revered. Millions of pilgrims take a dip in the holy waters of the Triveni Sangam to cleanse themselves of sins, seek liberation and attain spiritual enlightenment. While ritual bathing is considered sacred throughout the duration of the Kumbh Mela, specific dates hold special significance. The 'Shahi Snan' (Royal Bath) that takes place on these dates is believed to amplify the spiritual benefits of the sacred dip, allowing devotees to reap the blessings of the saints and their virtuous deeds.

PAUSH PURNIMA

(13 January 2025)

Marking the full moon's arrival, Paush Purnima inaugurates the Maha Kumbh Mela. This sacred day initiates an intense period of spiritual growth, devotion and self-reflection among pilgrims.

MAKAR SANKRANTI

(14 January 2025 - First Shahi Snan)

Makar Sankranti is a profoundly auspicious occasion, celebrating the sun's transition into the Makara zodiac sign. On this day, millions of pilgrims gather for the first Shahi Snan, a sacred bath symbolising spiritual rebirth. The day is also marked by charitable acts as devotees donate to the needy and underprivileged.

MAUNI AMAVASYA

(29 January 2025 - Second Shahi Snan)

It is believed that the stars align perfectly on Mauni Amavasya, making it ideal for a sacred bath. This day commemorates the story of Rishabh Dev, a revered sage who broke his vow of silence and bathed in the holy river. As a result, Mauni Amavasya attracts the largest gathering of pilgrims, making it a powerful day of spiritual growth, devotion and purification.

BASANT PANCHAMI

(3 February 2025 - Third Shahi Snan)

Basant Panchami marks the arrival of spring and honours Goddess Saraswati, the embodiment of knowledge. On this day, devotees known as Kalpavasis - who live a simple and austere life on the banks of the holy river during the Kumbh Mela - wear vibrant yellow attire to celebrate the occasion's significance.

MAGHI PURNIMA

(12 February 2025)

Maghi Purnima holds great significance as it honours Guru Brahaspati and marks the divine descent of Gandharva to the sacred Sangam. Thousands of pilgrims flock to the holy ghats on this day, believing that their presence will bring them closer to spiritual enlightenment and heavenly blessings.

MAHA SHIVARATRI

(26 February 2025)

The final bath of the Kalpavasis at the Kumbh takes place on the auspicious occasion of Maha Shivaratri. This day is deeply connected to Lord Shiva and is said to be eagerly awaited even in the heavens. As the Maha Kumbh reaches its climax, a sea of devotees pay homage to the Lord.

PRAYAGRAJ, WHERE FAITH **CONVERGES**

Prayagraj, the ancient city of Allahabad, is a sacred confluence of spirituality, history and culture. Located at the meeting point (sangam) of the Ganges, Yamuna and Saraswati rivers, it is a city of spiritual significance, attracting millions of pilgrims and tourists every year. However, this ancient land has several other attractions to discover and explore.

TRIVENI SANGAM

The Triveni Sangam is the sacred confluence of the Ganges, Yamuna and Saraswati rivers. The distinct colours of the river waters make their meeting point clearly visible. The sangam is a breathtaking sight, especially during sunrise and sunset, and can be reached by boats. The evening aarti is an experience like no other.

PRAYAGRAJ FORT

Prayagraj Fort, built by Mughal Emperor Akbar in 1583, is a majestic structure that stands as a testament to the city's rich history. The fort's imposing walls and intricate architecture showcase the engineering skills of the Mughal era. Within the fort's walls lies the Saraswati Koop and the Akshayavata Tree.

PATALPURI TEMPLE

Patalpuri Temple, located within the Prayagraj Fort, is an ancient temple with old icons of deities. This subterranean temple is a unique example of Indian architecture, and its intricate carvings and serene atmosphere make it a must-visit destination.

MANKAMESHWAR TEMPLE

The Mankameshwar Temple, situated on the banks of the Yamuna River, is a revered Shiva temple in Prayagraj. It is believed that the temple was built by Lord Ram for his wife, Sita when she expressed her wish to worship Lord Shiva.

SANKATMOCHAN HANUMAN **TEMPLE**

Dedicated to Lord Hanuman, the temple also has idols of Lord Shiva, Parvati, Ganesh, Bhairay, Durga, Kali and Navgarh. The idol of Lord Hanuman was installed by Saint Samrat Guru Ramdas Ji.

LALITA DEVI TEMPLE

Dedicated to Goddess Lalita this revered temple is among the 51 Siddha Shaktipeeth in the country. It is located in Mirapur and is about 108 feet high. There are several statues inside the temple and an ancient pipal tree within the compound.

AKSHAYAVATA TREE

The Akshayavata, located within the Prayagraj Fort, is a sacred fig tree believed to be eternal and indestructible. It is said that anyone who worships it or dies under it attains salvation. Pilgrims who come here tie threads on the tree and pray for their wishes to be fulfilled.

ALL SAINTS CATHEDRAL

The All Saints Cathedral, designed by Sir William Emerson, is a stunning example of Gothic architecture in India. This beautiful church, built in 1870, has intricate work and designs on its marble altar, stained glass panels, arches and a grand pulpit.

MINTO PARK

Steeped in history, Minto Park is the site where the East India Company formally transferred power to the British Government in 1858. This pivotal moment marked the beginning of the British Raj in India. The park also has a stone memorial and is a must-visit destination.

SHRINGVERPUR DHAM

VINDHYACHAL



Dos

- Pilgrims are requested to use the bathing areas/ ghats that are authorised by the Mela administration for their safety and security.
- 2. Pilgrims are requested to use the bathing places/ghats nearest to their place of stay in Mela area or the city.
- Contact the Mela administration or the police control room if any unidentified or suspicious object is located.
- 4. Pilgrims are requested to follow traffic rules and regulations in the city and the Mela area.
- 5. The directions and advice given through the Central Public Address System may be followed to avoid any inconvenience.
- 6. Garbage should be thrown only in dustbins.
- Pilgrims and travelers are requested to be appropriately attired considering the religious and cultural sensibilities of the event. The local service providers will be happy to give advice on this issue.

Don'ts

- 1. Use of plastic bags in Prayagraj is prohibited by the Government and the Honorable High Court during the Kumbh Mela.
- 2. Washing of clothes on the river banks should be avoided.
- 3. Overcrowding of boats must be avoided.
- Pilgrims and travelers are advised not to encourage beggars.
- 5. Use of soaps while bathing in rivers should be avoided.
- 6. Throwing of materials used for worship or rituals in the river should be avoided.
